# Eligibility & Rules

- Must be a full-time employee or the son or daughter of any owner, partner, officer or full-time employee of a WVWA Class A Wholesale Member in good standing.
- Must be a high school senior accepted for admission in the fall of 2016 or presently enrolled in an accredited college or university on a full-time basis.
- Scholarship is intended to be used for tuition, books and supplies only.
- Applications must be received by June 25th end of current school year.

### **Awards**

One \$2,000 and three \$1000 scholarships will be awarded for one full year of study. Students may reapply to the program each year they meet eligibility requirements.

# Selection of Recipients

Scholarship recipients are selected on the basis of:

- High school or college grades
- ACT/SAT scores and class rank
- Extra-curricular academic and non-academic activities including church, community and employment
- Original essay on either career objective or a meaningful experience (no longer than three typewritten pages). Much emphasis will be placed on this portion for John Hodges Memorial \$2,000 Scholarship.

#### Selection

The West Virginia Wholesalers Association Scholarship Committee will select winners.
